# Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund

---

The Jackson County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority (JCBRA) is a sanctioned authority created to address brownfield sites County-wide, which includes assisting participating municipalities and developers through the use of tax increment financing, grants, loans, and other incentives. One of the brownfield tools the JCBRA manages is a \$1 million Brownfield Cleanup Revolving Loan Fund awarded in 2009.

## What is a Brownfield?

- A brownfield is defined as real property where the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse of which may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant.

## Eligible Borrowers:

- Any public or private entity with control or access to a brownfield site
- Cannot be a past owner or operator during release of contamination
- Cannot cause or contribute to the contamination



## Eligible Activities:

- Cleanup Activities

## Terms of the Loan:

- Low interest rate
- No match required
- Negotiable terms
- Funds can be used in combination with other financing sources
