NextGen Energy

The Jackson County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority of Jackson County approved a Brownfield Plan for NextGen Energy's new headquarters at the former Ford Plant located at 221 Mill Street in Brooklyn. The facility will be used for research and development. NextGen Energy intends to renovate this facility, but at the same time retain as much of the original turn-of-the-century mechanical items in the plant as possible such as the water mill.

NextGen Energy is Michigan's leading developer of alternative, sustainable and renewable energy sources. The project is expected to be a \$1.5 million capital investment and create about 25 jobs. Additionally, Oakland University will employ approximately 25 additional university personnel at the Brooklyn site.
